<b>Antech Cuvee Expression Brut AOC Cremant de Limoux Sparkling, France</b> A blend of Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, and Mauzac made in the same method as Champagne, it is fragrant of delicate, creamy, honeyed toast and white flowers. Only hand-picked grapes from the best and oldest vines are processed for the Numerus Clausus. an exclusive terroir wine produced in a very limited edition. It matures in barriques for 30 months and impresses with its incredibly concentrated, yet gentle and well-balanced taste.		
<b>Masi Costasera DOC Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Corvina, Italy</b>	2015	7,590
A classic example of a top Amarone, this wine shows the typical notes of prunes, dark cherries, and raisins. This is a powerful wine that pairs best with heavy meat dishes, hard cheeses or chocolate desserts.		
<b>Chateau Faugeres AOC Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Fran, Merlot, France</b>	2009	7,950
Intense notes of blueberry, blackcurrant, and toasted. Elegant palate, fresh at the outset, juicy in the middle, and developing complex floral aromas in the finish.		
<b>Chateau D Armailhac AOC Pauillac Grand Cru Classe, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Fran, Merlot, Petit Verdot, France</b>	2011	10,050
The intense and complex nose exhales perfectly ripe fruit aromas followed with airing by succulent roast coffee and blackberry notes. From a full and dense attack, the mid-palate reveals elegant and well-rounded tannins which underpin liquorice flavours with hints of refined and elegant oak. The long and flavourful finish lingers on red fruit flavours and chocolate notes.		
<b>Chateau D Armailhac, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, France</b>	2016	10,250
One of the most popular Bordeaux wines in Thailand and here in one of its best vintages. Classic Pauillac characteristics of pencil lead, cassis and cedar wood with a long lingering finish. Enjoy with meat dishes or pastas.		
<b>Chateau Pichon, Longueville Comtesse De Lalande, Petit Verdot, France</b>	2005	20,050
One of the best “Super Second” Chateaux and in a legendary vintage, this is about as good as it gets in Bordeaux. A complex and intense wine that is starting to show some development, but still teeming with fresh dark fruits and new luxurious French oak.
