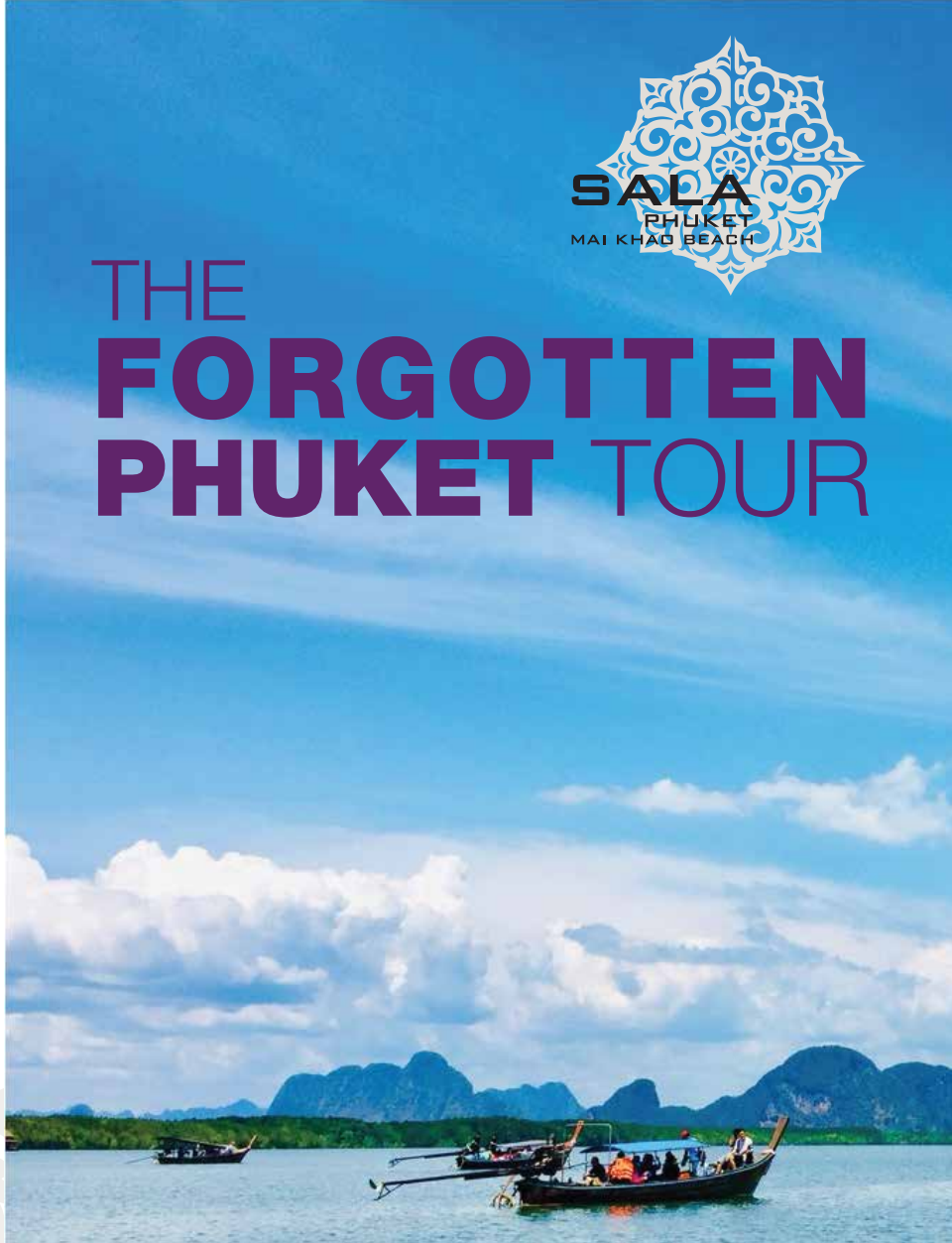




THE FORGOTTEN PHUKET TOUR



Explore the “other” side of Phuket with a tour of the island’s lesser-known attractions and discover deep insights into the local way of life. The four-hour Forgotten Phuket tour starts with a guided kayak ride through the mangrove forest, before heading to a traditional village to learn the art of creating beautiful tie-dye clothing. Following a rubber-tapping demonstration, guests can enjoy a unique long-tail boat ride and try hand-line fishing, just as coastal villagers have done for generations. This special day ends with a sublime seafood lunch overlooking Sarasin Bridge, where Phang Nga Bay meets the Andaman Sea.

Available every Monday and Thursday.

Tour includes: Land transfers, long-tail boat ride, kayak hire and light refreshments.

What to bring: Sunglasses, sunblock, hat and cash for extra purchases.

- 10:30 a.m. Tie-dyeing activity
- 11:00 a.m. Visit Samchong fishing village
- 12:00 p.m. Rubber tapping demonstration
- 1:00 p.m. Hand-line fishing and experiencing the life of a local fisherman
- 2:30 p.m. Lunch at Thanoon seafood restaurant (optional) and return to SALA Phuket
